### **Bronze**

These metal scrapers are designed for aging facilities with thinning tube walls. Phosphor bronze spring grade is half as hard as spring steel and more robust than plastic. It will safely remove hardened deposits with no fear of further tube degradation. Additionally, phosphor bronze is rust free, promoting a longer life.

The spring steel cleaners provide overlapping blades to ensure complete tube to wall contact of the cleaner. Its rounded blade ends assure gouging will not be an issue.
